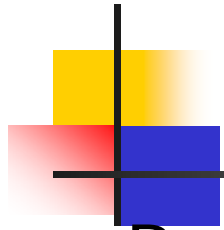

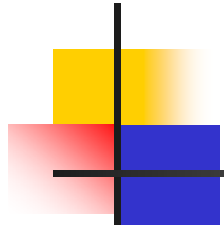


Recognizing that the Seoul Declaration on Occupational Safety and Health serves as a platform for commitments by TRIPARTITE constituents in many countries, particularly RALI member countries in promoting OS&H at work,

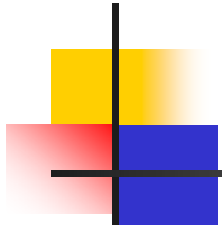


- Realizing the need for further actions at both the national level and the regional level in this field to implement measures outlined in the Seoul Declaration in prevention, risk management and social security through completing national policies, managing risks and promoting social security, particularly in the mining and related high-risk industry,
- Recognizing that accident insurance, accident preventive strategy and risk management strategy will contribute to the implementation of safety net and social security strategy,


The Conference recommends to:

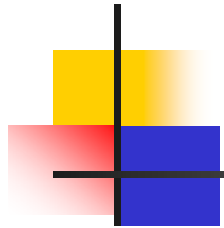


- 1. Collect, share information and improve accident insurance and reporting, occupational safety and health, labour inspection and other preventive measures and undertake comparative studies in these fields
- 2. Strengthen networks of experts in safety and health at work at the enterprise, sectoral, national and regional levels to promote prevention, risk management and social security, promoting integrating OSH training in labour skills training programs



- 3. Promote ratification and application of ILO Promotional Framework for OSH Convention (No 187), ILO guidelines on OSH Management Systems (ILO OSH-MS 2001) and other key ILO OSH instruments
- 4. Intensify, in cooperation with ISSA and ILO, the dialogue between RALI and the EU, Korea, Germany and other countries on occupational accident and disease preventive measures and insurance

- 5. Promote the principles enshrined in the Seoul Declaration to enterprises, particularly to SMEs, as well as industrial, in particular high-risk sectors, countries and the region as a whole
 - 6. Share OSH information and good practices through RALI, report them regularly to RALI Meetings and incorporate prevention, risk management and social security in RALI OS&H plans of action; and
 - 7. Organize regular meetings for sharing the information on the implementation of this Recommendation Statement.
