## **Berlin, 8 to 10 June 2022**

Accident rates on construction sites worldwide are still too high. The "Vision Zero" approach can help reduce the number of accidents.

Following up on the ISSA Construction symposia in Brussels (2009) and Boston (2012), the section plans to hold another symposium in Berlin on the topic of "How to reach Vision Zero in Construction".
