The Start-up Pitch Battle, which was part of the "XXXIst International Symposium of the ISSA Construction Section", focused on the question "How to improve safety and health on construction sites through digital innovations?".

7 international start-up companies from Germany, Chile, the USA, Japan, France, and Israel participated in the battle either through online connection or in person on site. They presented their innovative solutions in the field of occupational safety and health on construction sites to the symposium participants.

The participants of the symposium voted for the winner of the Start-up Pitch Battle, which was finally won by the German company "EASI Control".

EASI Control presented a multi-layered occupational health and safety management system that can be used via a mobile app and via computer application.

This digital platform helps to maintain an overview of all occupational, safety and health issues and automatically identifies the need for action. For example, it enables the registration of personnel, inventory and deficiencies, the distribution of responsibilities and the analysis of risk assessment. Necessary action measures are automatically derived from the company data and can be implemented directly on site.
