Isabelle Sancerni ISSA Vice-President



Isabelle Sancerni was elected as the Vice-President of the ISSA in June 2023, at the 127th Meeting of the ISSA Bureau. Ms Sancerni is the President of the Board of Directors of the National Family Allowances Fund (*Caisse nationale des allocations familiales – CNAF*) since 2018. The Fund heads a network of 101 family allowance funds in France. These organizations manage 34 benefits which relate to the family, housing, disability, and social inclusion, for an amount of nearly 99 billion euros.

Ms Sancerni is a member of the ISSA Bureau since 2018.

She is Chairperson of the Technical Commission on Family Benefits and a member of the Finance Committee of the ISSA Bureau.

Isabelle Sancerni has led the ISSA Focal Point for French-speaking countries since its creation in March 2022; the Focal Point comprises member institutions from 32 different countries.

She is also President of the Board of Directors of the European Representation of French Social Security Institutions, an association which defends the values and interests of French social security within the European authorities, and which monitors the European situation for its members.
