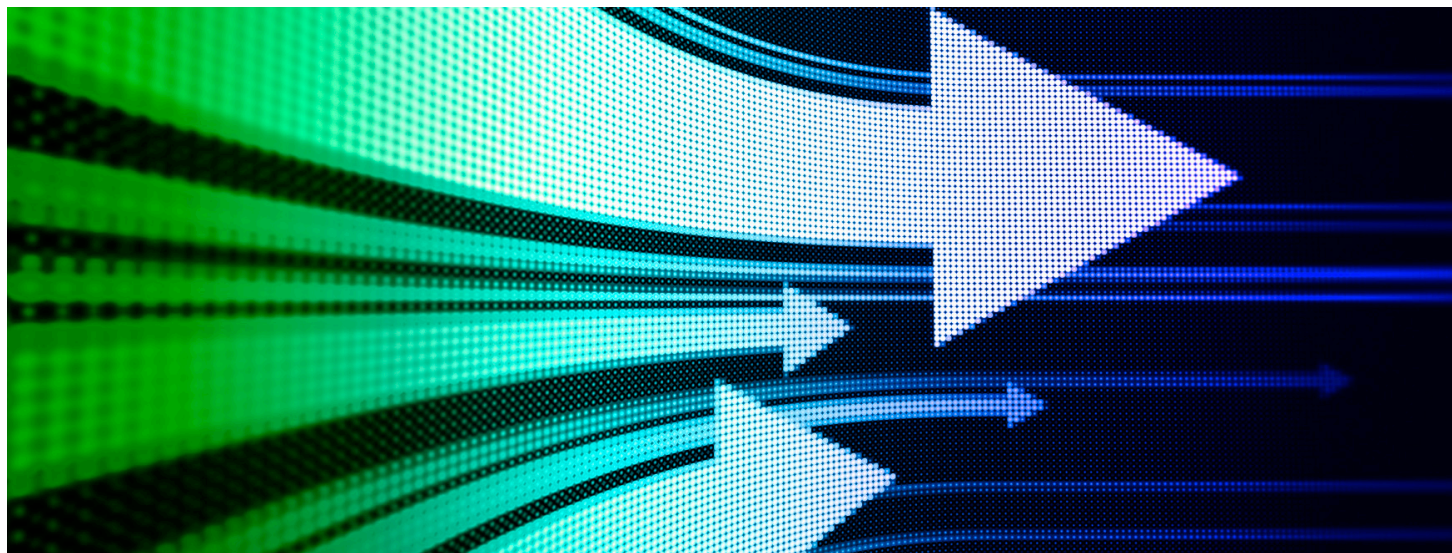


The ISSA Good Practice Award for Africa 2014



The ISSA Good Practice Award programme recognizes good practices in the administration of social security carried out by ISSA member social security organizations.

The ISSA Good Practice Award for Africa will be presented at the Regional Social Security Forum for Africa, in Casablanca, Morocco, in December 2014. ISSA member organizations in the Africa region are invited to submit entries for the Award competition.

The ISSA Good Practice Award is attributed on a regional basis over a three-year cycle at each ISSA Regional Social Security Forum. The Award, and Certificates of Merit, are decided by an independent international Jury.

Who can participate?

- ISSA member organizations in the region of competition may submit proposals for good practices.
- An ISSA member organization may submit one or more entries.
- Good practice submissions must be endorsed by the senior management of the organization.
- ISSA Good Practice Awards are given to organizations and not to individuals.

How to enter a good practice?

- Members may submit projects using the online form available on the ISSA web portal.
- Submissions which are transnational must be joint submissions or be validated by all the institutions concerned.
- There is no fee to submit an entry.

Good Practice Awards topical priorities

The ISSA Good Practice Award will be attributed to entries that relate to one or more of the following topics:

- Good governance
- Service quality
- Information and Communication Technology
- Contribution collection and compliance
- Investment of social security funds
- Return to work and reintegration
- Workplace health promotion
- Prevention of occupational risks
- Actuarial valuations
- Communication by social security administrations
- Extension of coverage to difficult-to-cover groups
